As the Community Outreach Specialist, you will develop marketing materials to attract clients to our Financial Opportunity Center (FOC), outreach to the community via individual and group information sessions at partnering nonprofit organizations to enroll parents of young children in the FOC, outreach to businesses frequented by potential clients, like laundromats, bodegas, supermarkets, hair and nail salons, barbershops, parks, and childcare providers, organize workshops, provide facility tours, capture client and employee testimonials, and keep accurate records of FOC outreach activities.

- Earn a \$25,500 stipend payable by bimonthly direct deposit.
- Earn an additional \$6,895 education benefit to pay down qualifying student loan debt or to continue your education.
- Access to health insurance program at no premium cost to you.
- Available childcare assistance benefit, if eligible.
- Participate in a 3-day, in-person leadership conference in Indianapolis, IN, in March 2024.
- Receive ongoing coaching, mentorship, and professional development.

What Your Work Environment Will Be

An 11-month position where you will typically serve 40 hours a week, normally Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., with occasional evenings and weekends. You will report in person to the FOC office in Perth Amboy and will be required to travel locally for meetings and community events.

- Have lived experience or an interest in working with a diverse group of people.
- Identify as any generation but are at least 17 years old.
- · Possess unexpired proof of status as a US citizen or permanent resident.
