Who We Are

The United Way of Central Jersey's ParentChild+ Family Child Care (FCC) Program is a free professional development program designed to support home based child care providers in their role of helping young children prepare for school and life success.



We know how invaluable child care providers are to families and children. For that reason we are implementing a program with the flexibility to address the wide variety of family child care environments.

- FCC is a home visiting model. That means twice a week for 45 minutes, an early learning specialist will visit your home, during the workday, and bring free learning materials for you to keep in your centers.
- During these one-on-one visits, our specialists will model engaging reading, conversation, and play activities using the materials of the program.
- Through this partnership, the learning specialist and you will work together to engage children in positive communication, build strong interest in learning, and prepare children for the next step in their education.

The Details

Over the course of 24 weeks...


- You will receive 48 Home Visits.
- We will visit 2X a Week for 45 minutes filled with Games, Music, and Movement.

During the first visit of each week your specialist will bring a new educational toy or book that is yours to keep.

- You will acquire a Library of 12 High Quality Books and 12 Educational Toys.
- You will receive 24 Curricular Guide Sheets with tips on vocabulary-building, skill development, social-emotional development, and imaginative play.

These guide sheets will highlight enrichment activities and conversation opportunities related to the books and toys you receive. They are yours to keep and we encourage you to implement your own early literacy activities for the children in your care.







ParentChild+ graduates enter school performing 10 months above their chronological age.



ParentChild+ participants have 30% higher graduation rates than their underserved peers.

Family Engagement

We also work one-on-one with providers to support their role in facilitating family engagement for all the children in their care.

We ensure each child receives 2 books every month, the same books as providers, along with informational guide sheets to continue learning at home with their families.
